

Insurance Discounts

Several states offer discounts on comprehensive insurance when customers install GPS theft recovery devices. The current list of these states is:

Florida	Illinois	Kentucky	Louisiana
Massachusetts	Minnesota	New Mexico	New York
Pennsylvania	Rhode Island	Texas	Washington

Passive devices such as ignition cutoffs, alarms and electronic auto recovery systems (which are automatically activated when the car is locked and do not depend on the driver to remember to activate them) may qualify for up to a 30 percent discount.

Massachusetts residents are eligible for a minimum 25 percent discount if they have both an antitheft device (such as an alarm) and an electronic recovery system, **such as an AutoWatchman device**.

Some insurance companies in states that do not mandate discounts also encourage vehicle owners to install antitheft and theft recovery devices by providing customer discounts at their discretion.

Insurance premium discounts will vary, depending on the state and/or province you reside in, and the insurance provider. When you contact your insurance company regarding your model vehicle and your driving history, you will be able to confirm what discounts are available.

To make sure you qualify for an insurance discount, contact your insurance agent.
